Project is Latest in Long List of Historical Renovations for Tower

Tower General Contractors announced that it has been selected to renovate the historic Beverly Hills City Hall Building. The renovation of the 1932 Italian Renaissance style City Hall is set to begin late 2007.

Designed and built in 1932 by architect William Gage, Tower General Contractors will renovate the building to preserve its historic architecture and interior design. The Building has deep roots in Entertainment. Will Rogers, a top actor in the 1930’s, became honorary mayor of Beverly Hills and went on to play a part in the

development of Beverly Hills by fostering construction of the building in 1932.
