Located on the Universal Studios Lot, the Gibson Amphitheatre is operated by LiveNation, the world's largest source of live concerts, music venues and festivals.

Part of the Hollywood landscape for over thirty years, the Gibson Amphitheatre has hosted many memorable performances from the Rolling Stones to the MTV Movie Awards. As the third largest venue in California, the theatre seats up to 6,189 for concerts. Pre-construction for the renovation has begun and construction will be accelerated for a projected completion date. Renovation of the historic venue will raise the ceiling height above the stage to accommodate more elaborate and extravagant performances and larger scale props.

The Gibson Amphitheatre was built in 1972 as an outdoor venue. In 1982 the theatre was converted and remodeled to an indoor venue. It is the third-largest theatre in California, behind the Nokia Theatre and Shrine Auditorium, both located in Los Angeles. Gibson Amphitheatre is famous for its acoustics and its sightlines and considered one of the finest theatres in the United States.
