Presentation Highlights The Arroyo Vista Family Health Center

LOS ANGELES, Ca. (February 14, 2008) –Tower General Contractors, the largest minority-owned general contractor in Los Angeles County, recently presented at the Pan American Healthcare Exchange in Long Beach, California.

“The demands of the Arroyo Vista project presented considerable challenges to all parties,” commented Alex Guerrero, Executive Vice President of Tower General Contractors. “But the result was the opportunity to take pride in constructing an affordable healthcare facility that would be used by a large community of people.”
